## The DELF (Diplôme d'Études en Langue Française)

*The DELF (Diplôme d'Études en Langue Française)* is an official qualification awarded by the French Ministry of Education to certify the competency of candidates from outside France in the French language. These diplomas are valid for life.

*The DELF Prim* is designed for children aged between 7 and 11 years old . It is divided into 3 levels: A1.1, A1 and A2, corresponding to the Common European Framework for Languages (CEFR).

*The DELF Junior* is suited for students aged between 11 and 18 years old. The exams test abilities in the CEFR levels A1, A2, B1, and B2.

The following linguistic skills are assessed:

1. Listening Comprehension
2. Reading Comprehension
3. Written Expression
4. Oral Expression/Interaction

Each candidate needs to obtain at least 50 points out of 100 in all four exam skills mentioned above to earn a diploma.

*The DELF Junior* is recognized as a proof of French proficiency for internships as well as college and university applications!
